Programming Team

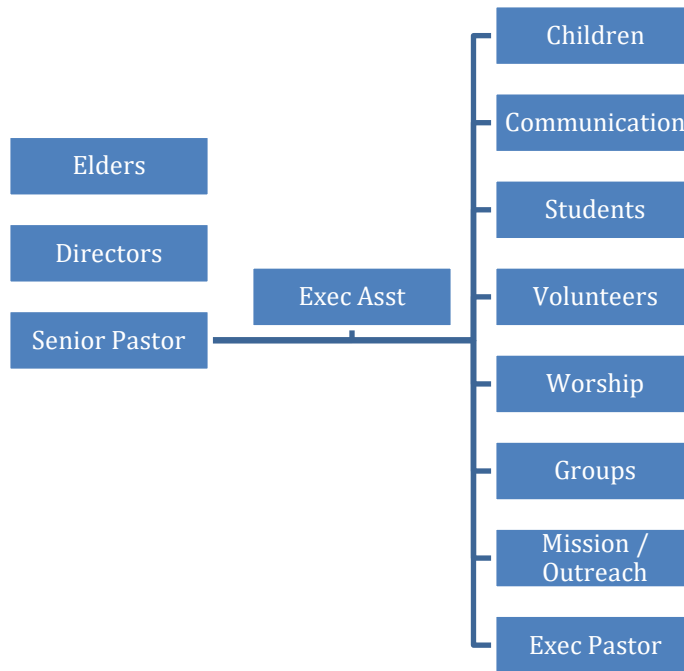
- Meets weekly with Programming Team to design mid-week and weekend services
